

Summer Camp Equipment

Full uniform

Scout hat or activity hat (bucket hat, straw or etc.)

6 T-shirts (at least 6) Scout related or plain

6 pairs of underwear (at least 6)

6 pairs of socks (at least 6)

1 extra pair of shoes

1 pair of sandals or flip-flops for use at the pool or shower only.

Toiletries – soap, deodorant, bug spray, sun screen, toothbrush and toothpaste – in a separate bag or container - they must be put in the trailer at night. These are smellables and will attract unwanted critters.

Small first aid kit

Water bottle

Merit badge books

Paper (notebook)

Pens or pencils

2 swim suits

2 towels

1 pair long pants

1 long sleeved shirt

Raincoat or poncho (You might want a small folding umbrella for light rain. It can get very hot in a raincoat.)

Flashlight

Whistle

Insect repellent

Knife (only if you have a totin chip)

Compass

Sleeping bag or sheet and blanket

Day pack to carry water, Scout Hand Book, merit badge books, paper, pens, rain gear and first aid kits

Lockable trunk to store your equipment (duffel bags **will** get wet). If you bring a duffel bag, place it on your cot before leaving the campsite. It will rain and your stuff will be wet.
